



Young Drama Cambridge Audition at Hills Road Sixth Form College on Saturday 5th April.

Registration will take place from 1.15 pm – 1.30 pm at the Main Hall, Hills Road Sixth Form College, Cambridge, with the audition running between 1.30 pm - 3 pm.

National Performing Academy is looking for young actors with bags of energy and personality to join 'Young Drama', a Saturday drama school in Cambridge. Acting ability is required, but previous theatre experience is not essential.

Please read all the following information carefully, and complete the attached Registration Form (last page) to be brought to the audition.

Audition Information

The audition will last approximately one-and-a-half hours.

The audition will be in a workshop style and structured like one of our drama sessions. Prospective students will get the chance to showcase their acting skills throughout the audition in groups.

No preparation is needed as everything will be taught on the day.

Students must be at least 9 years old by 1st April 2025 and no older than 16 by 1st August 2025.

Prospective students must be accompanied by a parent or guardian during Registration, and a designated waiting area will be provided if you wish to stay for the duration of the audition.

Students must be collected from our auditions and sessions. If you wish to give permission for them to leave unaccompanied, you can sign a consent form on the Audition Day.

What to wear and bring

We ask that auditionees wear comfortable clothing and suitable shoes, tie long hair back, and bring a drink and a snack.

Should your child be asthmatic, have allergies, or any other condition which may require medication, please ensure they have this with them and make us aware at registration.

What we're looking for

Throughout the day, we will be looking for young actors who show acting ability, enthusiasm, and the ability to follow instructions.

If successful, what happens next?

You will hear back from us via email that your child has been successful, and will be given instructions on how to enrol and pay term fees via our online portal.

Successful auditionees will not be required to re-audition each term, so once you're in, you're in!

How to get to the venue

The audition will take place at Hills Road Sixth Form College, Hills Road, Cambridge, CB2 8PE.

Parking is available next to the College on Purbeck Road, Cambridge, CB2 2PF. There will be signage to the Main Hall from the car park.

If you wish to use public transport, there are bus stops outside the College on either side of the road.
